### Product use

Liberon Wax and Polish Remover removes old wax, dirt, smoke and everyday grime from antique and modern wood furniture and interior wood work including doors, beams, dado rails, and banisters without harming the original finish and patina. This unique formula should not lift veneers or raise the grain, making it suitable for even the most delicate surfaces. Use to remove built-up layers or wax which may be causing a haze or bloom on the surface.

### Product application

For best results soak a pad of Liberon Ultra Fine Steel Wool (0000) in Wax and Polish Remover, squeeze out the excess and gently wash the surface going with the grain where possible. Allow a few minutes for the Wax and Polish Remover to work, then while the surface is still wet use a clean lint-free cloth to wipe off all the old softened wax. Repeat this process until all the old wax is removed. Allow 24 hours for the treated surface to dry completely before re-finishing.

**Important:** This product may lift newly applied French polishes, lacquers, varnishes and sealers. Always test product first on a spare surface or inconspicuous area to check colour, compatibility and end results.

### Precautions

Wear suitable heavy duty gloves. Do not pour into plastic containers or use on plastic or vinyl surfaces. Dispose of used steel wool and cotton cloths outside to reduce vapour build-up and fire hazard. Do not use on water based varnish.

### Packaging

Wax and Polish Remover is available in 250 ml, 500 ml, 1 L and 5 L containers.

### Health and Safety
